and environmental benefits. On average, one US

dollar investment into restoration of degraded land

case studies call for increased investments into the

rehabilitation and restoration of degraded lands, including through such institutional and policy measures as strengthening community participation for sustainable land management, enhancing government effectiveness and rule of law, improving access to markets and rural services, and securing land tenure.
