GUIDELINE FOR ADMINISTRATION OF FENTANYL FOR PAIN ...

- Onset of action after IV administration of Fentanyl is 3-5 minutes; duration of action is 30-60 minutes. Women should be observed closely for signs of adverse reaction and possible respiratory distress. Naloxone should be close at hand for emergency administration.
